Session Descriptions

Session I

"Fun on the Farm"

June 28 – July 2

We will spend our day taking care of our farm animals: collecting our hens' eggs, grooming the pony, feeding the animals, playing with our bunny rabbit, giving fresh water to our ducks. The children will learn how to interact and have hands-on contact with our friendly and fun farm animals, including ducks, chickens, pony, and bunny rabbit. There will be **daily pony rides** as well for those children that wish to participate. We will learn about many other farm animals; as well as discovering how foods come direct from a farm; lots of crafts; interesting stories about farm animals and life on the farm; and of course play time will make the day zoom by! There will be several take home items the children will have made during camp.

Session II

"Sew a Stitch"

July 12 – July 16

Children will learn basic sewing skills, some advanced, both hand and machine stitching. Students will be introduced to other forms of sewing, including cross-stitching and jewelry-making. Lots of projects! Memories journal, sewing kit, sit-upon, sewing buttons...many more! In addition, there will be play-time, story-time, snack-time.

Session III

"Grow a Garden"

August 9 – August 13

Hands-on planting and gardening activities; learning about the life cycle of a seed; crafts -- making unique growing containers and other fun garden items; exploring the "flower" teepee; interesting stories about gardening and growing; and of course play time will make the day zoom by! There will be several take home items the children will have made during camp. The children will experience -- either through plants already planted or seeds which they will start -- radishes, squash, cucumbers, herbs, apples, sweet peas, carrots, garlic, tomatoes, onion, moonflowers, peas, beans, corn -- to name a few.

Pre-Registration Required. Registration Cost \$125 per week for Sessions I and III, \$150 for Session II. No Refunds prior to 2 weeks of camp start date. Must bring own sack lunch; drinks & snacks provided. Classes with insufficient enrollment subject to cancellation.
